

2020 FULBRIGHT JUNIOR RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM (JRS)

GENERAL INFORMATION/PROVISIONS:

Fulbright Thailand (Thailand-U.S. Educational Foundation), in cooperation with the Thailand Research Fund (TRF), is pleased to announce the “**Fulbright - Thailand Research Fund (TRF) Junior Research Scholarship Program (JRS)**,” which is aimed to develop the capabilities of Thai university staff members and interested persons to gain **six months** of research experience in the United States **as part of their doctoral dissertation requirements**.

Five (5) grants are available for the **2020** academic year. **Two (2) will be awarded under the Fulbright Program and up to three (3) will be under the Fulbright-TRF partnership.** For the grant sponsored by Fulbright Thailand, benefits are intended to cover round-trip international airfare, monthly stipend for six months, in-transit allowance and health insurance. For the Fulbright-TRF partnership, funding support will be mainly provided by the Thailand Research Fund (TRF) with additional fund from Fulbright Thailand for a period not exceeding six months.

Fulbright Thailand will assist the grantees in the visa process, coordinate with the host U.S. institutions and offer non-monetary benefits, including orientations, enrichment seminars, international conferences, etc., which will help grantees to get access to their chosen host universities and create quality international networks.

ELIGIBILITY:

At the time of application, an applicant must:

1. Be **physically present in Thailand** at the time of the application, interview and orientation
2. Be a **Thai citizen** in good health (*individuals holding U.S. immigrant visas or permanent U.S. resident cards / green cards, or dual citizenships (Thai and U.S.) are **not eligible** to apply*);
3. Be a **university lecturer OR interested persons who are undertaking graduate work at the Ph.D. level in a Thai university**;
4. Have completed your coursework and passed the qualifying exam;
5. Demonstrate strong academic performance at the graduate level;
6. Have an appropriate background to undertake the proposal you have outlined;
7. Have the concurrence of the university Ph.D. program in which you are enrolled;
8. **Have one of the following valid English official score reports. (Preferably submitted with application before the extended deadline, but also acceptable on the day of interview):**
 - a. **IBT TOEFL score of 71;**
 - b. **ITP TOEFL score of 525;**
 - c. **CU-TEP test score of 75.**
9. **Obtain an official letter of invitation from a U.S. host institution/advisor will supervise the research (Preferably submitted with application before the extended deadline, but also acceptable on the day of interview);**
10. Be able to take leave from your home institution or post;
11. Preferably not have had extensive experience in the United States **during the previous 5 years**; and
12. Be able to fully participate in every activity organized by Fulbright Thailand, including Preliminary Orientation and Pre-departure Orientation Program, which will be held in January and June respectively.
13. Those who work for the U.S. Embassy and related agencies, please consult Fulbright Thailand before applying.

- *Grant period must not start before September 1, 2020 and no later than February 28, 2021.*
- *Fulbright grantees will apply for a J-1 VISA to participate in the Fulbright Program. The process will be administered and facilitated by Fulbright Thailand.*
- *Failure to meet any of the requirements makes an applicant ineligible*
- *Plagiarism is NOT acceptable. You will be automatically disqualified if found plagiarizing.*

It is solely the applicant's responsibilities to strictly follow the instructions.

GUIDELINES FOR ONLINE APPLICATION

1. All items must be completed in English and use **American date notation** (month, day, year)
2. All attachment files must be in the format of **PDF only**.
3. **For transcripts and official English score report, a scanned copy must be of the original documents.** However, please include only **photocopies** of those in your hard-copy application packet. ***Please do not mail us the original documents.***
4. **Letters of Recommendation:**
 - It is highly recommended that the recommenders are those qualified to evaluate the applicant's qualification.
 - Applicants must include **two letters of recommendation in sealed envelopes** (*sealed by the recommenders*) in the application packet OR the recommenders themselves email their letters (*a scanned copy*) directly to tusef@fulbrightthai.org with the subject: **Letter of Recommendation for JRS Application**. The two recommenders need not choose the same method of submitting their letters. In other words, one may opt to submit by emailing to tusef@fulbrightthai.org while the other in a sealed envelope.
 - The recommenders must use **official/professional e-mail addresses** registered/associated with their institutions/organizations to ensure their credential. ***A personal email address is not accepted.***
5. Applicants must submit **both online application and a set of hard-copy application.**
 - Applications must be submitted online **by the extended deadline on Friday, November 15, 2019 at 1:00 p.m. Thailand local date and time.**
 - Once completing online application, applicants must print a hard copy from the Online System and send a set of hard-copy application to Fulbright Thailand Office **via EMS with a postmark by Friday, November 15, 2019.**
 - **Please do not staple any of your hard-copy document. Use paperclips instead.**
 - Any incomplete application and any documents mailed to Fulbright Thailand Office later than the date indicated above will not be considered.

JRS APPLICATION CHECKLIST:

- 1 original application form (with a photo attached) printed from the online application system
- Detailed research proposal (not exceeding 5 pages typed, font no.10-12 Ariel or Tahoma, preferably)
- Biographic essay (not exceeding 2 pages typed, font no.10-12 Ariel or Tahoma, preferably)
- Resume/CV
- A copy of transcripts (Master's and PhD's)
- A copy of valid English language official score report (TOEFL iBT or ITP or CU-TEP)
(Preferably submitted with application before the extended deadline, but also acceptable on the day of interview)
- An official letter of invitation from the U.S. institution (a copy of a PDF file is acceptable)
(Preferably submitted with application before the extended deadline, but also acceptable on the day of interview)
- Two letters of recommendation (sealed in envelopes or email directly to tusef@fulbrightthai.org)
- Please do not staple any of your applications. Use paperclips instead.
- Your documents must be in or translated into English only.
- Please attach PDF files only, and the size of each file cannot be over 8 MB. Each PDF file can have multiple pages.
- A scanned copy must be of the original documents.
