Applicants

The Applicants are categorized into two groups;

- Individual Applicants.
 1. The applicants can apply by themselves as individual applicants.
 2. the participants of individual applicants are limited 10 persons. if they have been full, the applicants will be suggested to the following period.

2. Recommendation letter (from University/International Relations Office/faculty//Department/Unit/etc. of the home country)
3. Sending the application form (The application form can be **downloaded here**)
4. it is highly recommended to have an international health insurance.


